Patti and I were in Prattville, AL for the Drive-In Ministries Board of Directors meeting the middle of this month. We were guest of Mike and AnnaMae Jones. Mike is the Director of Drive-In Ministries and he and AnnaMae have been with Drive-In for 21 years. We got to see board members and missionaries from all over including Colombia, Guatemala, and Romania. This ministry has people and equipment on the mission field in the US, Mexico, Central and South America, Caribbean, Africa, India, Indonesia, and Romania to name a few places where they have operations today.



I met with friends from Mobile that had asked me to travel with them to Brazil the first two weeks in August to do programs for children. They have been involved in church funding and construction for about 5 years. It is a long and expensive trip and they have never done work with children’s programs in the past. This would be something new. Unfortunately, they have not been able to travel there since 2019 like so many other ministry organizations. We will be at The Mission of Hope on June 17th and then we travel to Carrabelle, FL for a Forgiven Ministry powerful “One Day with God” in the Franklin Unit. This is when the children go into the prison to spend the day with their father for a full day of fun filled events and time with their kids. Training with be on Thursday night June 23rd at the unit. Last year we had volunteers from Michigan, Texas, NC, and GA!

Pastor Roy Stebbins introduced us to the “Southern Baptist Convention Disaster Relief” organization. They have teams that respond during disasters like hurricanes and tornados. We are interested in the Chaplaincy program and their work with the different crews when called out for disaster help. I will keep you informed.
