Significado: (Description written by the artist, Victor M. Castro)

The white lines represent the cross of Christ.

Four sectors are established: Two on the right and two on the left; two above and two below. (painting is flipped in picture)

The right is the field of Christ and the left is the field of Satan.

Above is the field of God and Christ.

Below is the earth, the world, and humanity under the direction of the devil.

The right is light and life; the left is darkness and death.

The vertical white cross is Christ touching God with his head and with his feet touching sinful men. His feet have crushed (wounded) the head of Satan.

The horizontal cross touches evil on the left and on the right the good.

The cross is the way. Everyone who believes in Him passes from darkness to light, from death to life.

Joe reports: We have had a busy and very blessed July into August. Our son Joe and I had a great Fathers training at "The Mission of Hope" with "The Power of the Father's Blessing" and forgiven ceremony for around 45 men the end of July. Then Patti and I headed to Georgia for a Forgiven Ministry "One Day with God" at the Atlanta Re-entry Facility for 23 fathers, 38 of their children, their caregivers, around 90 Forgiven Ministry volunteers and close to 30 Correction Officers. The "Godly Dad's" training was on Friday for the men and the kids arrived early Saturday morning. I was blessed to do three 45-minute programs Saturday. One was for the caregivers and then early Saturday morning for just the fathers and Saturday PM for the fathers, kids, volunteers, and prison staff. Many lives were forever changed during these two days!

We pulled our travel trailer and camped in Hamilton, GA with our friends and ministry volunteers, Kim and Trisha on their farm the first night. We left with them and their RV headed to Atlanta for the event and did the same on the return trip back to Mobile. We love camping on their farm/ranch and getting a little visiting in with them, their horses, cows, wild turkeys, and deer roaming their pastures and Kim's great cooking of their own farm raised beef!

We will be back a "The Mission of Hope" on the 18th, then pull out for Monticello, FL on the 23rd for another 'One Day with God" at Jefferson Correctional Facility on the 23rd of the month.
