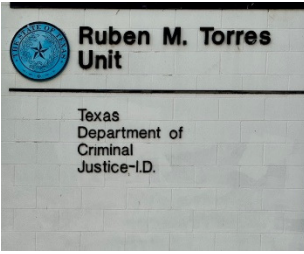




Joe McDonald Ministry

In 2003, Joe was called into full-time ministry. As an “itinerate” missionary, Joe and his wife, Patti, have been all over the globe sharing the Gospel message in schools, churches, and prisons, as well as huts, yurts, fields, and stadiums. Their mission statement: “To share the Gospel of Jesus Christ, wherever God sends us.”

With crowds as few as twenty and as many as five hundred, Joe performs slight of hand and gimmicks with participation from the crowd and fun music, always ending with the Salvation message. If you’re really good, he might bring RK Possum or Henry, his wooden boy. He adjusts his program, both timing and content, depending on audience age and needs of the site.

He has partnered with many churches over the years, and ministries that have become faithful friends. One such ministry is Forgiven Ministry, located in NC, who take the children of inmates into prisons to spend a day with their parent. Joe and Patti have traveled all over the US with FM, always incredibly blessed to see the reconciliation of families. Another state-side ministry is local to his hometown, Mobile, Alabama, The Mission of Hope. Joe provides a monthly Fathers Seminar, training and encouraging men in addiction recovery on restoring their relationship with their children. Joe’s son has been helping with this special time with fathers, grandfathers, and even future fathers.

Although they have travelled the world, including Mongolia, Thailand, Africa, Haiti, Mexico, Central and South America, and more, in 2020, when international travel became slight, Joe built a “parade float” featuring pictures from Patti’s children’s book, “The Gospel Parade.” By participating in holiday parades and other outdoor fun, Joe and his family and friends get to “throw” candy, Gospel tracts and “Jesus Loves You” bracelets (thousands, at last count,) always sharing the Good News with a lost world. Never asking for pay or accommodations, God has taken care of Joe McDonald Ministry for over 20 years, with faithful supporters, and generous honorariums.
