From the first part of February until the first part of March, we were in 7-8 time zones and time changes.

Good question, Lee. With travel trailer intow for both trips, the Florida trip was 650 miles and the Georgia trip 995 miles! With the time change to daylight savings, that covers about 3 time changes!

Our daughter in law's mother, sister and three children plan to travel from Atlanta and participate with us for the first time. Son, Joe, and hosts Debbie and Phil Smith of Wee Can Know, will also be riding with us. Remember, this is the parade that drops a half a million pounds of produce to the spectators!

From there we travel the next weekend to Carrabelle, FL for a Forgiven Ministry "One Day with God' in the Franklin Men's Institution.
