In 2025 we drove our vehicle for ministry work 9,250 miles, we pulled our travel trailer 7,374 miles to 22 campgrounds. We made a few trips with our new vehicle that many of you



helped us purchase. We made our first trip in 2026 with the cover for hauling our equipment. Our RPod travel trailer belongs to us, and we loan it to the ministry at no charge. With much travel scheduled for 2026, we are praying about a larger used travel trailer. We need to sell our RPod before that. If you know someone

Our first trip from Mobile this month was to Wakulla, FL, and Wakulla CI for a Forgiven Ministry *One Day with God*. It was a powerful time for the 31 kids to be with their 20 dads and 20 caregivers. Many lives forever changed by accepting Jesus into their lives. We were scheduled to leave Tuesday the 17th for Middletown, TN for a church event there with our friend Mitch Tillman. He and his wife have *Harbor Evangelism* in Mongolia and Thailand. He called to tell us they had to reschedule as the church had been damaged



during the ice and snowstorms there a couple of weeks ago. So, he traveled to Mobile to visit with us while his wife is still in Mongolia. We made two trips to Mongolia in the past to work with Mitch and *Harbor Evangelism*. We'll be at the *Mission of Hope* Addiction Recovery on Friday Feb 20 for “*The Power of the Father's Blessing*” We leave March 3-10 for Hartwell, GA and Hartwell Woman's Prison for another *One Day with God*. Right now we are preparing for the huge *Irish, Italian, Islenos* parade in Chalmette, LA. the second weekend in April. We partner with Phil and Debbie Smith of *Wee Can Know* yearly and hand out over 10,000 Jesus Loves You and The Way to Salvation info. Kim and Trisha Mobley from Hamilton, GA and our son Joe, Veronica and their 3 kids travel with us to help and ride in our *The Gospel Parade* float.

Patti has redone her website, professionalmom.com and we encouraged you to visit it, sign up for her monthly blog newsletter and provide feedback, stories and tips for moms and caregivers.

We have been blessed to share the love of Jesus and salvation message, invite people to church and give tracts and Little Jesuses all over Mobile and on all our travels.
