



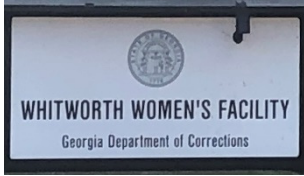

*“The Evangelism Trail” for March 2026*



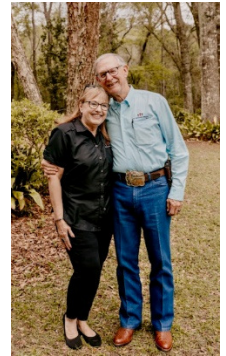
Our mission statement is: *“To share the good news of Jesus Christ wherever God sends us.”*

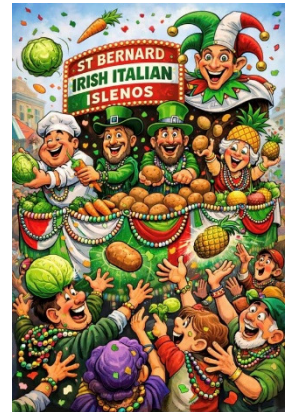
