Our mission statement is: “To share the good news of Jesus Christ wherever God sends us.”



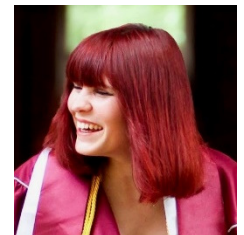
Patti and I have an electronic picture frame with pictures of children’s programs and ministry trips to various parts of Mexico, Central America, and other countries. As I watch from time to time I am reminded we would see, perform, and share the Gospel of Jesus with as many as 3,000+ young people each year. There



would be 40 and next time 400. (El Show de Joe) Like this picture of Robinson School in Chimaltenango, Guatemala for 400 students. And then I tell myself, “No wonder I am so tired!” The out of country trips have slowed to one each year (2025 Sao Luis, Brazil for the church dedication for SL and Joy Ann Williamson), we are still seeing young people and adults on a regular schedule. Most recently in April was Gadsden Women’s Facility in Quincy, FL. for a Forgiven Ministry “One Day with God” there. We had 25 moms, 47 children, 14 caregivers, 50 volunteers and about 2 dozen staff. Patti was a mentor for children who spent the day with their mothers inside the unit and she donated 35 of her books, *Hell is Forever: The Way of Escape* to the mothers and staff. I had the honor of doing two 45 minutes programs, each ending with the Salvation message and invitation. One for the caregivers and another inside the unit for the moms, children, volunteers, and staff. Words can’t describe seeing caregivers, mothers and their children make life changing decision to follow Jesus!



We have two grands graduating this month. JJ Price is our grandson in Dallas, TX. and Mikaela McDonald in Alexander City, AL. JJ will attend Dallas Baptist University and play basketball, and Mikaela will attend University of Mobile and study Theatre. Patti and I are so proud of both smart and loving grandchildren. A new chapter begins! Speaking of grandchildren, three of our Mobile grandchildren were in the Cottage Hill Christian School play “The Sound of Music.” Mia and Joey both had speaking parts and Naomi was the understudy for one of the main



characters. It was as good a play as we had seen and our speakers, singers and dancers were as good as the movie!



Our son Joe and I will be at the “Mission of Hope” on Monday the 11th for “The Power of the Father’s Blessing” father training. We leave for Dallas that week and the next week for Alexander City with our daughter Andrea McDonald for the two graduations. Patti and I have been invited to travel to Romania with our Georgia ministry partners this fall. Details to follow.
